## **AMENITIES GUIDELINES**

Upon purchasing your home in Hickory Ridge, you became a member of the Homeowners Association (HOA). All HOA members have access to the Hickory Ridge Community Amenities consisting of the cabana and pool. The pool and cabana are behind a card-access gate for security and health reasons. **YOU MUST HAVE A KEY CARD TO ENTER THE POOL AREA.** Cards are good year after year. If you do not have a card or are in need of a replacement card, contact NMI- [poolkey@nmitx.com](mailto:poolkey@nmitx.com) or 972-359-1548. Replacement cards cost \$25.

Remember...there is **NO POOL LIFEGUARD ON DUTY** therefore supervision of children is MANDATORY, and it is not recommended for anyone to swim alone. All rules for the Pool and Cabana area can be found posted at the site and/or are included here.

## **HICKORY RIDGE AMENITIES' RULES**

- **NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY - SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK!** The Hickory Ridge HOA assumes no responsibility for any personal injury to anyone resulting from use of the pool.
- Children 16 and under must have an adult, 18 years or older in attendance.
- In case of emergency, Dial 911
- No diving
- DO NOT swim alone.
- Proper swim attire is required.
- Swim diapers are allowed but all non-swim diapers must be covered with tight-fitting plastic pants. Diaper changes **MUST** be made in the restroom facility.
- All children must be supervised.
- No glass is permitted inside Pool gates.
- No running, diving, rough play and/or pushing in/around the Pool.
- No skateboards, bikes, scooters, or rollerblades inside the Pool gates and/or Playground gates.
- No eating or drinking in or near the water.
- Music and noise must be kept at a non-offensive level.
- Members are authorized to expel any person due to disruptive behavior, age, or lack of member present.
- No pets within the Pool gates.

- **NO SMOKING IN THE AMENITY CENTER AND POOL AREA.**

## **RESERVATIONS**

**If you would like to celebrate a special event at the pool, please observe the following guidelines:**

- ✓ **Celebrate during NON-PEAK hours of an amenity.**

Mondays-Fridays: 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.; 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.  
Saturday and Sundays: 10 a.m. to Noon.

Please be aware that the Community Amenities will remain open to all residents during your celebration. No individual party or gathering can monopolize the pool or playground areas. There can be only one reservation per area per time frame.

You are responsible for cleaning up after the celebration. Sweep the floor, wipe off tables, and pick up trash. Excessive amounts of trash should be taken with you and deposited in your home trash can. Leave the area clean for other residents – just as you would want it to be. The HOA Board of Directors reserves the right to charge a resident a cleaning fee of up to \$50 if an area has not been cleaned - as required - after a celebration.

- ✓ **Please make sure you have a safe adult-to-child ratio at both amenities.**
- ✓ **Party sizes should be limited to 20 people total – including guests, siblings, and parents.**
- ✓ **Be sure that all swimmers are aware that there is NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY, and that event participants swim at their own risk.**

The Board of Directors has the obligation and right to suspend the membership and pool privileges of any member who abuses their privilege or creates a safety hazard for others.***
